<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diapers in ALL sizes (families are always stretching their budgets to keep infants and toddlers dry and comfortable)</li> <li>• Potty training seats to insert in the toilet</li> <li>• Receiving blankets</li> <li>• Activity blankets for babies' "floor play time"</li> <li>• Onesies, underwear and socks in all sizes for infants and toddlers</li> <li>• Pajamas and blanket sleepers for infants and toddlers</li> <li>• Hoodies, coats, hats and gloves for infants and toddlers</li> <li>• Bibs with Velcro or snap closures</li> <li>• Sippy cups</li> <li>• Children's books (hard and soft cover &amp; squeaky) in English &amp; Spanish</li> <li>• 60 packs of construction paper, safety scissors &amp; glue sticks</li> <li>• 60 sets of flash cards (basic letters, shapes, numbers, etc)</li> <li>• 60 packs of cabinet locks for safety</li> <li>• 60 packs of outlet covers for safety</li> <li>• 60 stackable rings</li> <li>• 60 sets of large blocks can be wooden, plastic, Lego...</li> <li>• 60 toys that stimulate imaginary play (tea sets, kitchens, tool sets, dress-up clothes, hats...)</li> <li>• 75 Crayola Art Sets</li> <li>• 60 medium gift bags to put items in (can be purchased at Dollar Store)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sets of shower gel and lotion</li> <li>• Hats and gloves for men and women – 60 for women and 30 for men</li> <li>• All sizes of pajamas for men &amp; women</li> <li>• All sizes of hoodies for men &amp; women</li> <li>• Compact umbrellas</li> <li>• Disposable cameras (possibly a gift certificate for film processing)</li> <li>• Photo albums</li> <li>• Gift cards to local businesses</li> <li>• 70 pocket calendars to encourage families to keep track of appointments</li> <li>• Work gloves for dads</li> <li>• Scented candles</li> <li>• Back pacs (more user friendly than diaper bags for moms who use public transportation)</li> </ul>
