Prevent Child Abuse (PCA) Georgia's *Referral Guide for Abuse Treatment Services* provides a listing of mental health professionals who have demonstrated a minimum level of experience and training in working with survivors or perpetrators of child abuse. The practitioners listed in the *Referral Guide* submit an application to PCA Georgia and are reviewed for eligibility by a panel that includes professional peers who are not employees or agents of PCA Georgia.

This Standards' Review Committee consists of PCA Georgia staff and several mental health practitioners who represent a range of mental health disciplines. These clinicians are leaders in the mental health community as providers of child abuse survivor or perpetrator treatment. The Standards' Review Committee meets on a quarterly basis to review applications. Furthermore, the review panel serves as advisors to the *Referral Guide's* development, management, and application.

Following are the minimum requirements for clinicians listed in PCA Georgia's *Referral Guide for Abuse Treatment Services*:

- A Masters, Doctoral or Nursing degree in a mental health field
- Professional licensure valid and current in the state of Georgia
- Current professional liability insurance
- Twelve hours of continuing education, acquired within five years preceding application for listing, relevant to child abuse, abusers, and/or related issues
- Clinical experience working with survivors and/or perpetrators as indicated by three letters of reference from clinical supervisors and/or professional colleagues licensed in a mental health profession
