Prevent Child Abuse (PCA) Georgia is currently looking for volunteers for our **1-800-CHILDREN HELPLINE** which provides emotional support, resources and referrals to callers from across the state. We will train you to respond to questions about concerning behaviors in others and teach you how to offer support and options for callers who have an opportunity to prevent child abuse in their everyday lives through problem solving and connecting to available community resources.

Our Helpline operates between the hours of **8:00 am** and **8:00 pm, Monday – Friday**. Scheduling is flexible and you can volunteer during times that best fit your busy lifestyle.

You don't have to be a trained counselor or possess a background in social work. PCA Georgia will give you the training and support you need to contribute to this valuable community resource:

- 12 hours of mandatory training
- Call shadowing and experiential learning prior to staffing the line
- Continuing education

Volunteers must be 21 years of age and sign a one-year contract committing to a regular shift each week.
