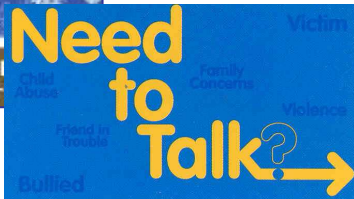
Because the **1-800-CHILDREN Helpline** is confidential, it is often the first point of contact for individuals in need and callers unsure of where to turn for help.
